### **Title**

### **Awareness Programs regarding Covid Pandemic**

#### **Objectives of the Practice:**

This institutional practice aimed to attain the following objectives:

To make students as well as citizens aware about Covid Pandemic

To help the local management by offering the space for isolation centre during Covid Pandemic

#### **Context**

It is the need of time to encourage and support the people during the Covid Pandemic period. Therefore, the college takes the initiative to make the people aware about this epidemic disease and this is done through organizing webinars and offering the space for Isolation centre for the affected people.

#### **Practice**

Notable practices are summarized below:

**1. Webinars:** The institution (Department of Geography and Department of Commerce) organized two webinars on Corona-Spatial Distribution, Lockdown and Changes in Environment on 25<sup>th</sup> June 2021. It aimed to create awareness about Covid among the students and people. Students were made aware of the preventive measures against Covid.

**2. Covid Vaccination Awareness Program:** The NSS Unit of the college organized Covid Vaccination Awareness Program on 12<sup>th</sup> March 2021. It aimed to make students aware about the importance and need of vaccination. Students were encouraged to get vaccination as a preventive measure against Covid pandemic. Besides, Dr. M. N. Survase uploaded his own video addressing the procedure and importance of Covid Vaccination that also creates awareness among the students and general viewers. 3. Besides the above activities, the institution provided a few rooms of the ladies hostel for creating isolation centre during the Covid pandemic. Masks were also distributed.

1. Registration and attendance of the participants in the program. About 165 participants registered and 65 participants attended the webinar on Corona-Spatial Distribution, Lockdown and Changes. About 141 participants attended the webinar on “Care to be taken during Covid-19”.
