

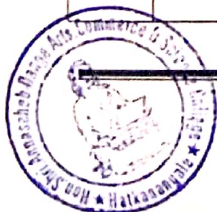


**Student Satisfaction Survey on overall institutional performance**

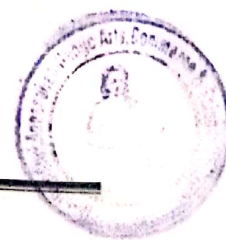


